Full-Time Dual Diagnosis Therapist at Premier Behavioral Health Services (PBHS)

Job Description:

Private practice in Mentor, OH seeking an independently licensed therapist to join our team in a full-time capacity.

We are looking for a clinician to join our Dual Diagnosis Team. Applicants with substance use treatment experience or interest are encouraged to apply. The clinician will see clients for individual psychotherapy and intake assessment evaluations within our multi-disciplinary team. Co-facilitation of an adult Dual Diagnosis Intensive Outpatient Program (IOP) may be available in the future. Experience with DBT welcomed but not required. Training will be provided within the Dual Diagnosis IOP. Previous group therapy experience is preferred.

Clinicians maintain flexibility in designing their schedules, and the practice currently adopts a hybrid model of remote and in-person sessions. Covid-19 safety protocols are in place to maximize safety for staff and patients.

Those with Dialectical Behavior Therapy (DBT) experience are encouraged to apply, however training in this modality will be provided. Previous group experience is preferred. As DBT emphasizes psychoeducation and didactic training, teaching experience and/or comfort engaging with small groups is essential. Familiarity with motivational strategies and confronting therapy-interfering behaviors also is suggested for applicants.

Clinician will participate in a variety of professional activities, including:

-Conducting initial diagnostic intake assessments

-Orienting new IOP patients to DBT and the IOP experience

-Individual psychotherapy

- -Participation in regular treatment team meetings
- -Professional consultation as needed

-Crisis intervention

- -Supervision of other clinicians (if consistent with licensure)
